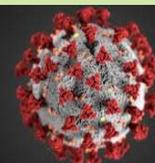
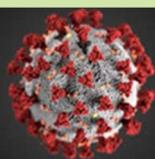

Non sustainable harvesting of plants parts may lead to loss of Biodiversity. COVID-19 should not give occasion for destroying our nature

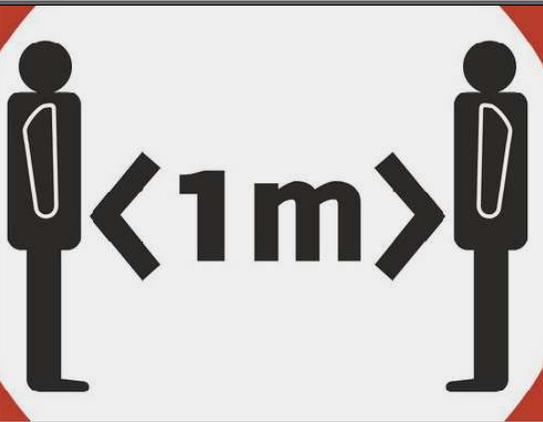


Engaging now in nursery development of mostly consumed non timber forest products (NTFPS) will promote post COVID-19 recovery for vulnerable groups
